<p>Other helpful items to donate are small balance gift cards to local food restaurants and local gas stations. We would require several gift cards in small amounts, ranging from \$5-\$10, to give to several people. Gas cards can range from \$5-10 from gas stations in the Twin Cities (e.g. Speedway, Holiday, etc.). The gas gift cards are helpful for people experiencing homelessness and live in their vehicles.</p>
