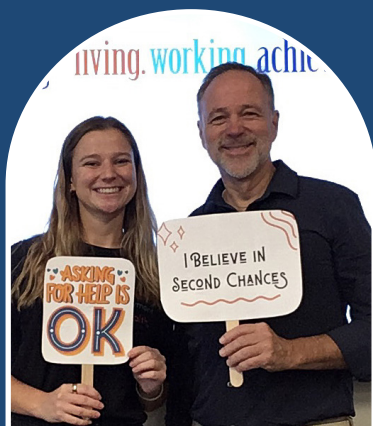

THE NEXT RIGHT THING: LORINDA'S JOURNEY TO HOUSING STABILITY

When Lorinda arrived in Minneapolis, she carried more than just her belongings—she carried hope. After leaving Kansas and a toxic relationship behind, she found herself homeless and uncertain about what came next. “Leaving everything behind in Kansas and coming to Minnesota was a little scary,” shares Lorinda. “But I had faith and belief that **I can do the next right thing to get out of the situation.**”

While exploring the neighborhood near where she was staying, Lorinda discovered the **Tasks Unlimited Resource Center.**

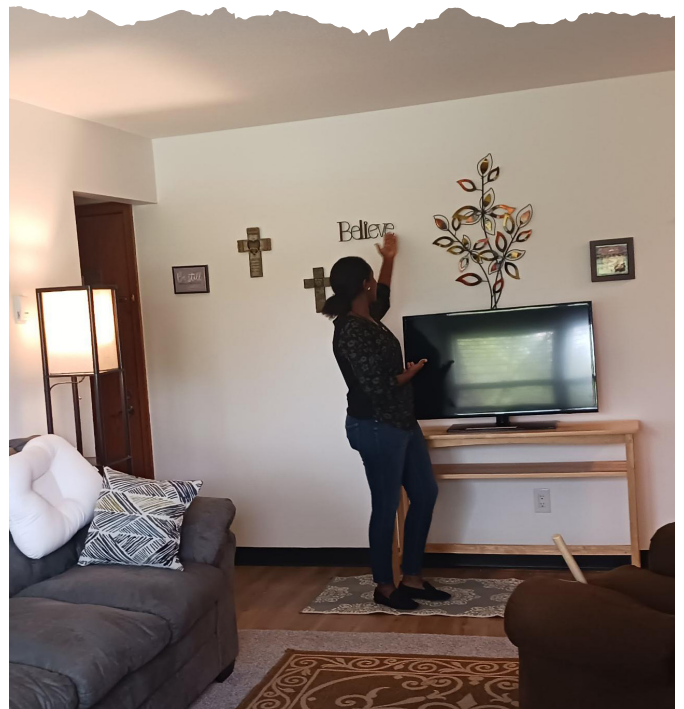
There, she was welcomed by staff and introduced to the **PATH program**—Projects for Assistance in Transition from Homelessness—funded by the Minnesota Department of Human Services.

Through PATH, Tasks Unlimited provides critical housing and resource navigation support for individuals facing homelessness. For Lorinda, that support was life changing.

She recalls meeting Sebli, PATH Outreach Coordinator, as a turning point: “She cried with me and heard me as I shared my story with her and encouraged me that the situation I was in was temporary, and that the PATH program will assist in helping find housing.”

Today, Lorinda is stably housed and looking forward. Her next goal? “To be a woman who reaches out to others in similar situations to help them find the courage and will to make the next right decision to better their life.”





REBUILDING TOGETHER: A FRESH START FOR OUR LODGES

At Tasks Unlimited, community and connection are at the heart of everything we do. Our Fairweather Lodges are more than just housing—they are places where peer support and shared living create belonging.

That's why we are thrilled to share how, this year, we teamed up with Rebuilding Together Minnesota (RTMN) to give two of our Lodges—the Astros and the Tasks Unlimited Training Center (TUTC)—a vibrant new look. Thanks to RTMN's incredible volunteers, these spaces now feel brighter, warmer, and more welcoming.

Ryan, our Property Construction Project Manager, works hand-in-hand with RTMN to make it happen. "At the Astros, we painted the interior, pulled up carpet to reveal beautiful hardwood floors, and added fresh landscaping," Ryan explains.

Similar transformations took place at TUTC, with new paint and carpet removal bringing fresh energy to the space.

But the upgrades go far beyond aesthetics—they make a real difference for the people who call these Lodges home. Ron, a resident at Astros, shares:

"IT'S WONDERFUL...I FEEL CARED FOR WITH THE NEW CARPETING, FURNITURE, AND TV."

Another participant adds: "The remodel changes how I feel about where I live. The new furniture, fresh paint, and flooring make me appreciate the house so much more."

These improvements reflect what we value most: togetherness, dignity, and creating spaces where everyone feels at home. A huge thank-you to RTMN and their dedicated volunteers for helping us make that vision a reality!
